The Conference of the Chiefs of Capital Police forces from Central and Eastern Europe and München, that was hosted in Warsaw, between 10th to 12th of October 2012, gave the General Directorate of Bucharest Police' delegation the chance to directly observe the efficiency and accuracy of some activities handled by the Warsaw Security and Crisis Management Bureau. I am extremely delighted by the warmth and complimentary manner in which the management of Bucharest Police depicted a part of the multidisciplinary tasks carried on within your organization.

The above-mentioned aspects can be concluded in the motivation needed to fundament our intention to launch in a fruitful cooperation with your institution, so that we may identify and implement the best practical solutions which have plentifully proved their viability and sustainability in Warsaw, accordingly to the general director of Bucharest Police.

In this respect, we are hereby bring to your notice our proposal to accept the visit of a delegation from Public Order Territorial Authority for Bucharest that is aiming to understand your institution by evaluating the organizational and technical components and also by acquainting the needed funds to budget the establishment and further feasibility of the center.
